

BAYAC RULES

1. All youth must participate and engage in scheduled activities and programming that are scheduled for the day.

2. No viewing gang related, nudity, violence and/or death related sites as well as chat sites; No eating and/or drinking allowed in computer area.

3. No damaging of BAYAC property or will be asked to leave immediately.

4. Zero tolerance policy for physical violence, threats, stealing, bullying, and disrespectful behavior (including name calling, diminishing others and talking back to staff); youth will be asked to leave immediately and must meet with coordinator.

5. Youth must clean up after themselves when they make a mess, this includes dishes and/or crafts and equipment. Failure to comply will result in first warning of the three warning system.

6. No inappropriate clothing (gang colors, tank tops, low cut shirts, short skirts and short shorts).

7. Remove hats and shoes only if they are wet or muddy.

8. Three warnings will be given if any of the rules are broken; first warning will be verbal, second warning will be written, third warning youth will be asked to leave the centre for one week and can only return with their parent/guardian in which the problem will be addressed by the Coordinator.
